

## Instructions for arrival

Life Science Center is located at Keilaranta 10–18. It's easy to reach by public transport, your own car or bike.

### Parking

There are limited spaces reserved for guests in the parking lot of the Life Science Center, so please be prepared to arrive in good time. In the Keilaniemi area, P-Kallioparkki offers parking in the vicinity at Keilaniementie 1.

Parking in the Life Science Center's visitor spaces is subject to a fee between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. It is possible to pay for parking using the [Moovy](#) and [ParkMan](#) phone applications or, alternatively, by paying for parking later on Moovy's website ([www.moovy.fi/maksa](http://www.moovy.fi/maksa)) no later than 48 hours after the parking event.

### Metro ([schedule](#))

Both metro lines M1 (Kivenlahti-Vuosaari) and M2 (Tapiola-Mellunmäki) stop at Keilaniemi metro station, from where it is a two-minute walk to the Keilaranta 18 entrance of the Life Science Center.

### Bus ([schedule](#))

Line 52 and main lines 550 and 510 move through Keilaranta, Kuusisaarentie and Otaniementie, and there is a distance to the nearest Otanimensilta stop two minutes from Keilaranta 10 entrance. Other nearby stops are Keilaniemi (M) and Otaranta.

### Raide-Jokeri / Light Rail line ([aikataulu](#))

The Keilaniemi terminus of Raide-Jokeri, or Light Rail Line 15, which will start operating in the autumn of 2023, is located directly in front of the Keilaranta 18 entrance of the Life Science Center.
